Profile

Sworn in in 2021 as part of the 83rd contingent of the Montreal Police Service, Officer Mohamed Lamine Benredouane had chosen a career in law enforcement out of a genuine sense of calling. Driven from a young age by a deep desire to protect and help others, he proudly embodied the values of the SPVM. Professional, humble, and driven by a strong sense of duty, he carried out his duties with integrity and wore the police uniform with immense respect and great dignity.

Born in Algeria and arriving in Canada at the age of 13, he grew up in the Côte-des-Neiges neighborhood. Proud of his dual Canadian-Algerian identity, he wanted to serve the community that had welcomed and shaped him, and requested to be assigned there as soon as he joined the SPVM.

Beloved by both his colleagues and the public, Mohamed stood out for his kindness, dedication, and remarkable interpersonal skills. His commitment to others was evident long before his career in law enforcement, when he served as a lifeguard in Algeria and Canada, helping to save many lives.

Beyond his uniform, Mohamed was an exceptional father who was always there for his family and deeply committed to them. His love for his family, his generosity, and his quiet strength have left a lasting mark on the lives of those who knew him.

Today, we honor the memory of an exemplary police officer, a respected colleague, and a man of great compassion whose courage, humanity, and dedication will continue to inspire future generations.

Circumstances of death

On June 22, 2026, late in the morning, officers from the Montreal Police Service were dispatched to the Côte-des-Neiges neighborhood following a call reporting an armed individual. Upon arriving at the scene, the officers were confronted with an extremely violent situation. During the operation, Officer Mohamed Lamine Benredouane was shot. Despite the rapid response of emergency crews, Officer Benredouane succumbed to his injuries.

This tragedy has deeply shaken the SPVM, the police community, his family, and the people of Quebec as a whole. On this day of remembrance, we honor a man who gave his life in the line of duty: protecting citizens. His courage, his dedication, and his ultimate sacrifice will forever remain etched in our collective memory.

Fallen, but never forgotten.
