TRADE IN YOUR TICKET

FOR A ROAD SAFETY INFORMATION AND PREVENTION SESSION



The SPVM will offer pedestrians and cyclists who receive a ticket during targeted operations, the chance to have the ticket cancelled. Offenders can “trade in their ticket”, if they take part in a road safety information and prevention session.

TRADE IN YOUR TICKET

improves the road safety record by targeting vulnerable clients who are frequently involved in collisions. Some rules are particularly targeted.

Pedestrians

- » OBEY TRAFFIC LIGHTS AND PEDESTRIAN SIGNALS.
- » CROSS AT INTERSECTIONS AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS.
- » MAKE SURE YOU HAVE BEEN SEEN. MAKE EYE CONTACT.

Cyclists

- » COME TO A COMPLETE STOP AT STOP SIGNS AND RED LIGHTS.
- » RIDE ON THE FAR RIGHT AND IN THE SAME DIRECTION AS TRAFFIC.
- » DO NOT RIDE ON THE SIDEWALK.
- » MAKE SURE YOU HAVE BEEN SEEN, ESPECIALLY BY DRIVERS OF HEAVY VEHICLES.



THE INFORMATION SESSION

When a pedestrian or cyclist does not obey the *Highway Safety Code* during a targeted operation, they have **7 days** after receiving the ticket to make an appointment at the phone number on the back of this leaflet. The offender will then have to attend an information and prevention session on pedestrian or bicycle safety, as the case may be, to have their ticket cancelled.

The information and prevention session, which lasts approximately an hour and a half, includes an interactive portion to encourage participation. It is based on the road safety practices advocated by the SPVM Section sécurité routière and the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ).

The sessions are offered by SPVM officers who confirm the attendance of the participants in order to have their tickets cancelled by the Direction des poursuites pénales et criminelles. If you attend the session, you do not have to pay the ticket. There is no possibility of a refund. But if you are unable to attend the information and prevention session, you will have to pay the ticket or file a not-guilty plea.

- » A PHOTO ID

- » THE SESSIONS ARE OFFERED IN FRENCH.
- » ONE SINGLE SESSION PER OFFENDER FOR THE DURATION OF THE “**TRADE IN YOUR TICKET**” PROGRAM.
- » MINORS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR TUTOR.
- » IF YOU ARE ATTENDING OR HAVE ATTENDED AN INFORMATION SESSION, PLEASE IGNORE THE NOTICE SENT FOR THIS TICKET BY THE MONTRÉAL MUNICIPAL COURT.
