Hate incident

Although a hate incident is not a criminal offence, it could nevertheless affect your sense of safety. To report it, fill an [online report](#).

Here are some examples of hate incidents:

- Distribution of offensive and unsettling material targeting an ethnic group.
- Insulting or abusing a person due to his or her social status in person, on social networks or otherwise.
- Committing vexatious acts against a person due to his or her sexual orientation.
